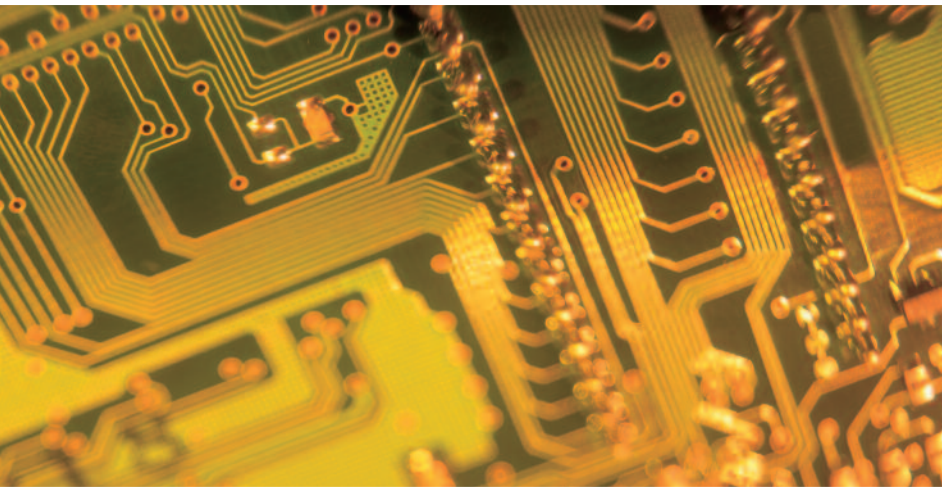
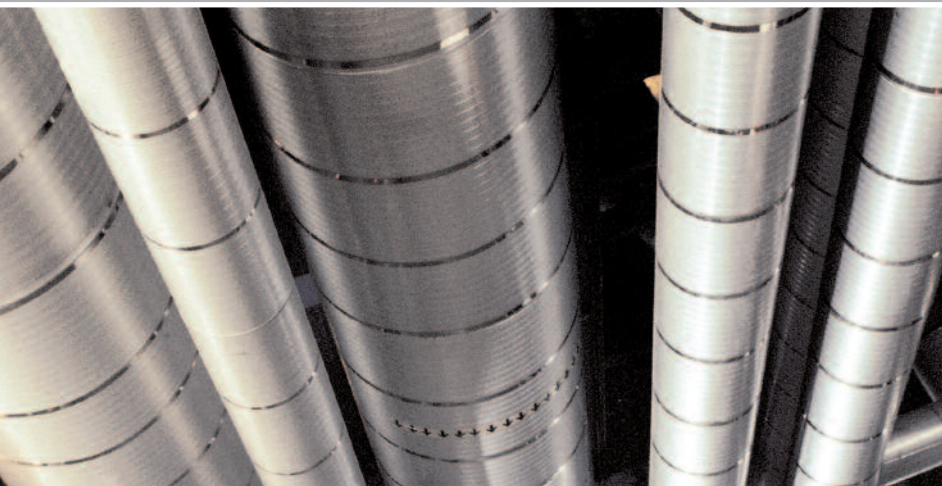

Help Getting Started

The following is a brief overview of the on-screen tools and commands.
You may wish to print these help pages for easy reference.



The **Finger** icon indicates that an area is linked to another document, or another part of the same document.



The **Adobe** link launches your browser and takes you to Adobe's site on the World Wide Web.



Open lets you find and open PDF files.



The **Print** command sends the current document to your default printer.



The **Navigation Pane** icon shows or hides bookmarks and thumbnails associated with a document.



The **Hand** tool allows you to grab an enlarged document and move it around the screen.



Click on an area of the page to **Zoom In**. Hold down the control key and click to **Zoom Out**.



Use the **Select Text** tool to copy a part of the text to the clipboard.



The **First Page** and **Last Page** icons jump to the beginning or end of the current document.

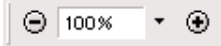


Use **Previous Page** and **Next Page** to move forward or back one page at a time.



The **Go Forward** and **Go Back** buttons retrace your path through a document, or return you to the original document after you activate a link.

▶ Help Getting Started



The **Magnification** box displays the current magnification and allows you to choose from a number of preset magnifications.



Actual Size displays the page at 100 percent of its printed size.



Fit in Window scales the document so the entire page fits in the available screen space.



Fit Width scales the width of the page to fit the available window.



The **Rotate View** tools permit you to view the current page turned 90 degrees in either direction.



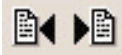
The **Find** command performs a simple word search within the current document only.



The **Search** icon activates the full Adobe index search utility.



Search Results shows a list of items found during your last search operation.



Search Previous and **Search Next** move you backward and forward through the items found during your last search operation.

The **Status Bar** at the bottom of the screen offers some additional controls.



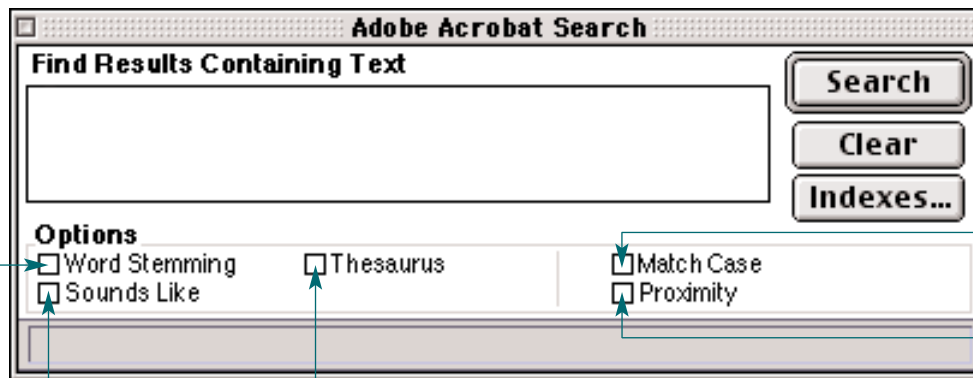
The **Window Splitter** allows you to adjust the amount of screen space allotted to bookmarks or thumbnails. Click and drag the control to change the split.

The **Page Number** box displays the document size and current page number. Click the box to jump to a specific page.

The **Page Size** box shows the printed size of the current page.

► Help Using Search

The **Search** utility allows you to search the *Approval Guide* for single words or phrases—even numbers, such as ZIP codes or product numbers. Type a word or phrase into the dialog box, and Search will quickly return the number and location of matches from the full text of the *Approval Guide*. The main dialog box functions are briefly explained below.



Sounds Like captures all the words that bear a grammatical resemblance to the one you typed. This switch is useful if you are unsure of the exact word you require.

Click on **Match Case** to limit your search to an exact combination of upper- and lowercase letters.

Proximity is a refinement of Boolean “and” searches. For an explanation of this and other advanced search topics, see the complete Search help file from Adobe.

The **Thesaurus** will add a search of words with similar meaning. This standard thesaurus does not include technical or scientific language.

Word Stemming pulls in all grammatical variations of a single word. “Extinguish,” for example, also would find “extinguisher” and “extinguishing.”

Search is capable of powerful, sophisticated search and refinement. For a more complete explanation of its functions, click the **Help** menu and choose **Plug-in Help** and **Using Acrobat Search**.
